All Level 2 Electric Vehicle Charger Rebate requests ("Application") with required documentation must be postmarked no later than January 31, 2026. ELIGIBILITY: Rebates are available to all existing Jewett City Department of Public Utilities ("JCDPU") residential & commercial electric service customers ("Customer") who purchase and have installed by a licensed contractor a Level 2 Electric Vehicle Charger on or after January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2025. Eligible measure must be installed in the JCDPU service territory and in the premises indicated on this rebate application between January 1, 2024 and December 31, 2025. Total rebate cannot exceed 100% of the total equipment and installation (labor andmaterial) cost of the eligible Level 2 Electric Vehicle Charger up to the maximum allowable rebate. Charger Installation Limit: One per residential electric account, two per commercial, multi-family or public area electric account.

APPLICATION OFFER: Jewett City Department of Public Utilities 2024-2025 Residential & Commercial Level 2 Electric Vehicle Charger Rebate program ("Program") covers eligible Equipment purchased and installation cost (labor andmaterial) on or after January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2025. Details of this Program, including rebate levels, are subject to change or cancellation without prior notice. This JCDPU Level 2 Electric Vehicle Charger Rebate Form("Application") with required documentation must be postmarked by January 31, 2026. Funding for this Programis limited to

The Customer also grants JCDPU the right to confidentially share account number information internally for rebate processing procedures.

By signing this document, and as a condition to receiving a rebate pursuant to this program, the customer acknowledges and agrees that any and all payments, benefits and/or credits associated with or applicable to the customer's participation in the program that is the subject of this Agreement in connection with the ISO New England, Inc. Forward Capacity Market ("FCM") or any existing, successor or replacement markets, (including, but not limited to, any and all transitional FCM credits or payments or any and all other capacity-related credits, payments and/or benefits for which such customer is eligible shall be deemed as capacity payments, credits and/or benefits of JCDPU. The customer hereby assigns to JCDPU all of its rights, title and interest in and to any and all such capacity payments, credits and/ or benefits, and agrees to take any and all action, including executing and delivering any and all documentation and/or instruments, as requested by JCDPU to evidence the same. FCM means the market for procuring capacity pursuant to ISO-NE Tariff, FERC Electric Tariff No. 3, Section III, Market Rule 1, Section 13, any modifications to the FCM, or any successor or replacement market/capacity procurement process.

CLASS III CONSERVATION CREDITS: Any Class III renewable energy credits and/or conservation credits received in connection with this program shall be retained by JCDPU pursuant to the laws of the State of Connecticut as of the date hereof.
